School for Parents provides a specialist service for families of children with cerebral palsy and other motor learning difficulties. We support families with babies and children under five years of age. Parents and children learn daily living skills together using the principles of Conductive Education.



The weekly sessions involve the children in active sitting, standing, stepping, walking, manipulation, communication, social skills, cognitive development and self-help skills. Children are motivated to learn through the use of fun activities, games, songs and stories based on termly topics.

The emphasis in School for Parents is to provide strong practical support for parents who have children with additional needs within a mutually sympathetic and encouraging environment. Parents are given tools to support their child's physical access and learning.

A highly skilled and professional trans-disciplinary team empowers parents to understand and appreciate their child's abilities and achievements and to have positive expectations.
